EVENT OVERVIEW



Summary

We are pleased to share the details of the successful execution of a professional development and Continuing Education Unit (CEU) event held at Snow Summit, March 2-4. The event aimed to provide free resources and support to individuals impacted by recent wildfires in the region. Generously supported by the newly established PSIA-AASI Assistance Fund, the event offered 100 participants access to on-hill clinics and up to 18 CEUs over 3 days.

Target Audience

PSIA-AASI Western Snowsports Professionals impacted by the Southern California wildfires.

Purpose

- Provide free professional development and CEUs to support recovery and continued professional growth for a deeply impacted member community.
- Offer a platform for networking and community building, recognizing that good things happen when we are together on the snow.
- Demonstrate the impact of members supporting members through the PSIA-AASI Assistance Fund.

BY THE NUMBERS

SURVEY DATA

- 100% of participants agreed this free rally helped reduce the stress and burden associated with maintaining their professional certifications this season.
- 100% of participants rated the overall quality of the clinics provided at the Western Wildfire Relief Rally as EXCELLENT.
- 100% of our teaching instructors agreed they would apply the skills covered at the rally to their professional snowsports instructing.
- 100% of participants stated that attending the rally helped them feel more connected to the PSIA-AASI community, including those who faced similar challenges this season.
